8 Steps to “National Cannabis Policy” Project Development

Territory Member/Representative is trained on Cannabis (2 hour course)
They receive a Certificate of Completion from CHA

Territory Member/Representative requests council meeting to discuss NCP

Territory Member/Representative leads the discussion to Council
or requests CHA to do so.

Leadership approves or denies cannabis reform.

Territory sends a Letter of Intent to work with the CHA.
This justifies the work in analyzing and creating a proposal for the territory.

Leadership completes our “Initial Interview Survey” on Cannabisandhemp.org

Leadership meets with the CHA to review a tailor-made proposition based on the territory’s unique and individual wants, needs, concerns, and resources.

Leadership chooses whether to use CHA as their NCP, find another developer, or go autonomous.
